Changing Verbs into Nouns:

Nouns are often made from the 4th principal part of verbs.

<u>Verb</u>	<u>Noun</u>
vincō, vincere, vicī, victus – conquer	victor – conquerer
pingō, pingere, pinxī, pictus – paint	pictor – painter
emō, emere, ēmī, emptus – buy	emptor – buyer
spectō, spectāre, spectāvī, spectātus – look at	spectātor – spectator
