

Stage 15 Common Test Errors

1. Continue reviewing the **prepositions**. What they mean as well as whether they take an accusative or ablative.
2. By far the greatest number of errors are due to a not close enough reading of the culture section. The test puts great emphasis on who was the leader of each people and whether or not they were friends or foes of Rome. The **readings in the boxes**, which are often ignored, are also highlighted on the test.
3. “**nauta**” – sailor, is a masculine noun of the 1st declension.
4. **Determining the right antecedent** is crucial in choosing the correct form of the relative pronoun. You must translate the relative clause to determine to what it is referring. The relative pronoun must then **agree** with its antecedent in **number and gender**.
