

1. scindō, scindere, scīdī, scissus

2. loquor, loquī, locūtus sum

3. “ablative absolutes” can be translated in many ways. The simple way is with the word “with”.

But “when”, “after”, “since” and others can also be used. Make sure that the sense and tense of your translation match the actual Latin participle.

4. “I run”, “I am running” and “I do run” are all present tense
