

Stage 5 Common Errors

1. The Latin word for "old man" is "**senex**".

nominative singular: senex nominative plural: senēs

accusative singular: senem

2. Remember that:

“ego” goes with a verb that ends in “**ō**” or “**m**”.

“tū” goes with a verb that ends in “**s**”.

3. "**cavea**" - general seating area.

"**orchestra**" - seating in front reserved for important citizens.

4. "**pantomime**" was a serious performance and was a mixture of opera and ballet and constituted the main performance of the festival.

5. The **protagonist** in a Plautus play was generally a "**clever slave**".
